The Poznań University of Life Sciences (PULS) is an institution with a rich history dating back to the late 19th century, rooted in an academic tradition from 1870. This was when, thanks to the efforts of August Cieszkowski, the university's current patron, Agricultural Halina School was established in Żabikowo near Poznań. This historical connection reflects the university's deep ties to the agricultural heritage of the region and its ongoing mission to advance the natural sciences and sustainable agriculture.

Today, it is a dynamic, modern university that combines a passion for science with innovative solutions for sustainable development. Our educational programs are designed to meet the challenges of the contemporary world, and the research conducted at the university sets new directions in agriculture, ecology, biotechnology, and life sciences. We invest in state-of-the-art laboratories and research infrastructure, and our faculty members are experts who inspire the pursuit of new solutions.

A supportive University



The University runs a Support and Development Centre which offer:

- supporting candidates, students, graduates and employees in various aspects of their activity related to PULS

- career coaching, self-development

The University is involved in many dedicated projects which enable the students to enroll for apprenticeships and internships (whether remunerated or not) and to take up a job in a company with a mentoring program in place. In that area, cooperation is established with specialized institutions and operators who take into consideration the specifics of education at the University or its Faculties.



An international University



As part of various international programs, academic exchange in education and professional development is supported for both students and academic staff. Students have the opportunity to study and complete internships at foreign universities or institutions under the Erasmus+ program. Academic and administrative staff can also participate in exchanges through this program. The university has 110 partnership agreements under the Erasmus+ program, 41 signed international agreements for scientific and research cooperation, and collaborates with 37 countries. The Erasmus+ program enables the admission of foreign students for studies and internships, as well as guest lecturers.

The University also offers courses in English. Bachelor's degree programs are available in Economics and Finance Management in the Agri-food Sector, Land Resource Management and Crop Plant Biology and Production. At the Master's level, programs are offered in Agronomy, Animal Production Management, Bioproducts Technology, Biotechnology, Wood Science, Horticulture: Seed Science and Technology, Environmental Engineering and Protection, Geoinformation and Spatial Management, Agri-food Economics and Trade, Food Science and Nutrition, and Forestry. Graduates from higher education institutions, both domestic and international, also have the opportunity to continue and supplement their education in English through the university's Doctoral School.

STUDENT CULTURE CENTRE

In addition to University classes, the students may find something for their bodies and souls. Anyone interested in folk dance and song may pursue their hobbies and passions in the „Łany” – The Folk Song and Dance Ensemble which has been a part of the University’s history already since 1974, and has been tremendously successful both in Poland and abroad. In addition to „Łany”, there is also the „Venator” – Hunters Trumpet Band which plays Polish and international hunting music and more, and the „Coro da Camera” Academic Choir playing musical pieces of various styles, from classical works to modern popular music.

STUDENT SCIENCE CLUBS

The Poznań University of Life Sciences offers a broad range of optional classes. The students may broaden their horizons, pursue their interests and passions and enjoy a purely scientific experience as they participate in many interesting research groups. The University runs 25 student science clubs supervised by devoted active leaders.

SPORTS CENTRE

The University has a Sports Centre, a well-equipped modern facility with indoor and outdoor courts, team sports halls, fitness zone and spa. The University also cooperates with an equestrian centre and a swimming complex. The centre includes 17 sports units under the University Club of the Academic Sports Association. The trainings are attended by more than 250 students who represent the University in many national and international sport events. Many of them have significant sporting achievements, especially in mountain biking, sport shooting, floorball or equestrianism.

CENTRE FOR LIFELONG LEARNING

The Poznań University of Life Sciences promotes education services aimed at updating and extending the graduates' knowledge and improving their professional skills in accordance with the Lifelong Learning concept. It offers courses, trainings and workshops, coordinates the post-graduate programs and runs the Life Sciences University of the Third Age. Also, it delivers and promotes the academic lessons offering targeted at junior secondary schools and secondary schools.

About Poznań



Poznań is one of the Poland's largest and oldest cities. Historically, it is the cradle of the Polish state which dates back to the tenth century. More than a thousand years of history have left many vestiges which, today, attract visitors to the modern yet historical capital of Wielkopolska. Located in the central-western part of Poland, in the Warta river basin, Poznań is the central point and capital of the Wielkopolskie voivodeship. Today, with a population of over 536 000, it is one of the Poland's largest cities.

Poznań boasts a large number of public and non-public higher education institutions which lead the national university ranking. More than a thousand professors are there to assist the students. The 25 universities offer over 200 majors, state-of-the-art education centers, extended international exchange programs, modern, high-quality campuses and programs that help the graduates enter the labor market. Poznań hosts over 102 000 students, including about 4 000 foreigners from more than 90 countries around the world. Each year, 25 000+ students graduate from the universities of Poznań.

Poznań, one of the Poland's largest financial and business centers, is the trade fair city which organizes over 50 trade events attracting nearly half a million visitors each year. A city of specialists and new technologies, Poznań is also a dynamically growing business center where the world's largest companies have their offices. In Poznań, almost 127 000 companies are active, and the number of foreign-owned companies is one of the highest in Poland. For many years, Poznań has had one of the country's lowest unemployment rates. The city might be said to be attractive and friendly to young entrepreneurs.
